The Test session was brought up and VE's volunteered for Saturday, Jan 20th. The next test was scheduled for March 17, the same week-end of the Fort Walton Beach Hamfest . The test will be moved but the date has not been set yet.

The program was a video of the Northern California DX Foundation, mostly asking for funds. It was informative as- far- as the activities of DX peditions that are taking place, and the availability of beacons for everyone to use to find band openings etc. That foundation has numerous videos for club programs available.

No further business was addressed and the meeting was adjourned with the Pledge of Allegance to the Flag.
